

Third Seal, Black Horse: Famine Revelation 6: 5-6

SCRIPTURE

Chapter 6

⁵ And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, "Come and see." And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand. ⁶And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, "A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine."

COMMENTARY

The third seal is opened, and the third creature calls, "Come!" The third horse comes forth, and is black in color. Its rider carries a pair of balances in his hand. The picture is terrible famine during and following a time of war. War always brings famine.

The balances picture that food is scarce, and wartime rationing is in place. A penny was a day's wages, and a measure was about two pints. The average family will be starving to death.
